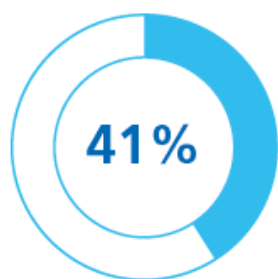

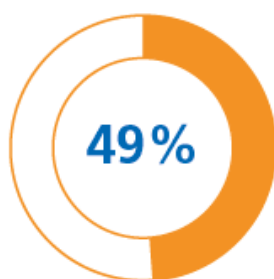
62% of the total clinical negligence provision (£58.2 billion)



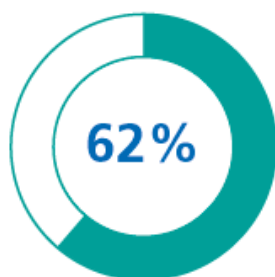
41% of the total clinical negligence **payments** (£2.8 billion) in 2023/24 relate to maternity. This is the same percentage as reported in 2022/23.



57% of **notified claims by value** (£6.6 billion) in 2023/24 relate to maternity. This is a decrease from 64% reported in 2022/23.



49% of the total clinical negligence **cost of harm** (£5.1 billion) relates to maternity. This is a reduction from 52% in 2022/23.



62% of the total clinical negligence **provision** (£58.2 billion) relates to maternity. This is a decrease from 65% reported in 2022/23.
