Please can I clarify does the entire request relate to children?

For instance, where you state:

1. The number of clinical negligence claims where the main injury is recorded as cerebral palsy, stillbirth, neonatal death, and paediatric death (paediatric death figures are only required if the initial claim type before the child died was cerebral palsy or brain injury).

Do you mean you only want us to capture the cerebral palsy claims where the patient at the time of the incident is a child (under 18yrs old)?

Are you also interested in brain damages claims where the patient is a child?

We look forward to hearing from you.

It might be helpful for me to separate the request for the number of claims from the request for the amount of compensation paid so that the responses for these do not need to relate to each other.

I don't want figures for historical injuries going back farther than the dates I have set out. So it might be better to reframe the questions as below?

1. The number of clinical negligence claims where the main injury is recorded as cerebral palsy, stillbirth, neonatal death, and paediatric death **and the injury occurred in the years below (so it is the date that the injury was allegedly caused rather than when the claim started – do you record the date of injury?)**.
2. The amount of compensation paid for each of these claim types for the years below- **appreciate these figures will not correlate with the above and this will be stated any time the data is used.** .
3. Please provide the information requested above in 1 and 2 but specifically for the Royal Bolton Hospital.

We do record the incident date. That is the date the incident occurred. Therefore, we can base the data on the incident date.

Do you want the entire request to cover just children? Particularly the cerebral palsy claims. Did you want Brain damage claims for children as well?

[You replied on 21 August 2024 with]

The earliest date I have requested data for is 2014/15. Someone who sustained cerebral palsy as an injury then would be only around 10 now so yes everything should only relate to children. I am only interested in CP/brain injury that occurred around the time of birth.

Let me know if you need any further clarification.

We will need to change the criteria to focus on the incident date instead of when the claim was notified to NHS Resolution.

Our Response

Please find attached the requested information we are able to provide.

NB: We have recently changed the way we report on our FOIs to align better with our published documents. Streamlining our reporting on FOIs with our annual published reports may mean a variation in snapshot dates. This means this data may not align with previous similar requests and it may not be possible for you to compare this information with a previous request. For this request we have used our Supplementary Annual Statistics (SAS) dataset to ensure the data represents the most up to date information. Therefore, our response to this request may not align with other publications on our website.

Claims notified/received in any given year will often relate to incidents that have occurred many years prior. Due to the nature of clinical negligence claims and the level of investigation needed to bring them to a resolution, claims received and notified in a specific year may take years to settle and close. They are not guaranteed to be settled and closed in the same year. As such, there will be a time gap between incident and claim closure.

As you have requested information based on the financial year the incident took place, please note that the information provided with this response will not be comparable to

other FOI releases, which are usually based on notification year or year of closure. This also means that recent incident years' data will not be fully mature in respect of claim numbers by incident date, as there is a significant lag in claims.

We have not provided the information for the claims closed with a nil damages payment as that has not been requested.

We have provided data on clinical cases only.

PPOs

PPOs are an agreement between the parties, to pay an initial lump sum and regular future payments (PPO damages) related to the injured party's ongoing needs, usually care for life i.e., a percentage of the full value of the claim is paid at the point of settlement (lump sum damages) with the balance paid at regular intervals over subsequent years. The information disclosed includes lump sum damages, costs and any PPO damages paid out as at 31 March 2024. It does not include PPO damages, which have been committed to but due to be paid after 31 March 2024.

Low Numbers

Please note we have suppressed low figures as we believe that disclosure of information with this level of granularity is exempt under Section 40(2) by virtue of section 40(3A) (a) of the Freedom of Information Act, where disclosure to a member of the public would contravene one or more of the data protection principles. The data protection principles are set out in Article 5 of the General Data Protection Regulation.

In some instances, the low numbers of claims (fewer than 5) in each category, the likelihood exists that individuals who are the subject of this information may be identified either from this information alone, or in combination with other available information. In addition to this, as this information is considered to be sensitive personal data (the data subjects' medical condition); NHS Resolution believes it has a greater responsibility to protect those individuals' identities, as disclosure could potentially cause damage and/or distress to those involved.
